Details:

- Instructors must have at least Intermediate Level of language proficiency with previous teaching experience as asset, but not necessary. Must be enthusiastic and passionate about teaching and learning their language.
- Fluent speakers will be compensated with an honorarium of \$320/week for five hours of direct class time and three hours of preparation time.
- Instructor/Tutors will be compensated with an honorarium of \$320/week for five hours of direct class time and three hours of preparation.

Courses will be:

- Delivered in small groups in the community that you live in with on-line delivery as well
- Team based delivery model with Instructor-Tutor paired with a Fluent Speaker support
- 5 hours of instruction each week for 8 weeks (for each course) plus 3 hours prep time
- Training will be offered at YNLC in September for Instructor/ Tutors and Fluent Speakers in developing and delivering the courses, teaching on-line and supporting/tutoring students

Applications will be accepted until August 18, 2020. Please submit a cover letter indicating the language you would like to teach and your ideas on how you would set up the course. Also provide an outline of your teaching experiences.
