Drawn in 1869 by the Tlingit Chief Kaalaxch' (Kohklux), this rare map is one of the few examples of Indigenous map making in the North. It is especially important to CAFN because it is the oldest map of dákeyi (our traditional territory). We want to share the story behind the map, as well as family and community stories related to the trade.
