- visiting student: wish to attend SFU as a visitor, taking credit earned at SFU back to a “home” institution. As a non-degree student you are not formally admitted to an SFU program, and will have low class enrollment priority: as well, space in upper level classes in often limited. Admission is competitive and all normal admission requirements apply. An exception is made for those visitors who attend on a formal exchange program with SFU.

- demonstrated commitment and/or excellence in other endeavours, or
- presented a clear and valid reason for attending the University, or
- succeeded in their studies in spite of difficult circumstances.

LITERACY & QUANTITATIVE SKILLS ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

LITERACY SKILLS

I meet (or I plan to meet) the SFU Literacy Skills Requirement in one of the following ways:

- High school: Completion of the last three years of full-time secondary school education in English in Canada. A minimum grade of 60% in English 12, English Literature 12, English 12 First Peoples or its equivalent in other provinces is required. I plan to satisfy additional literacy requirements within my first three terms enrolled at SFU (eg. completion of FAL X99).
- Postsecondary: Completion of a three unit English (ENGL) course or a certified W (writing intensive) course for which Simon Fraser University grants transfer credit, with a minimum grade of C-.
- Obtain a satisfactory score on one of the following English language proficiency tests: IELTS; TOEFL iBT; Canadian Academic English Language (CAEL); Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE Academic); or LPI. QUANTITATIVE SKILLS

I meet (or I plan to meet) the SFU Quantitative Skills Requirement in one of the following ways:

- High school: obtain (a) a grade of 70% or higher in BC high school courses Foundations of Math 11, Precalculus 11, Principles of Math 11, Foundations of Math 12, PreCalculus 12, Principles of Math 12 or Application of Math 12. Foundations of Math 12 or their equivalents from other provinces or countries, **OR**
(b) obtain a grade between 60 and 69% in Foundations of Math 11, PreCalculus 11, Principles of Math 11, Foundations of Math 12, Precalculus 12, Principles of Math 12 or Application of Math 12 **AND** (a) achieve a grade of at least 20 out of 30 in the SFU Quantitative Placement Test taken within your first term at SFU or (b) take the SFU course Foundations of Analytical and Quantitative Reasoning (FANX99-4) within your first three terms at SFU.
- Postsecondary: meet the high school requirements **OR** obtain a grade of C- or better in a transferable math or certified Q (quantitative) course from a recognized college or university.

PROTECTION OF PRIVACY

Admission Deposit for New Students

New students must pay a non-refundable admission deposit to confirm acceptance of the offer of admission to undergraduate studies given by the University.
